

Inotex hosted the ECWRTI project meeting

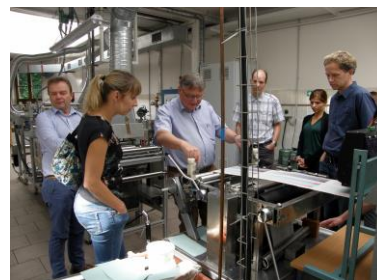


On 14th and 15th June 2017 INOTEX hosted the regular consortia meeting of the ECWRTI project.

The first day of the meeting took place in Parkhotel Praha. During the sessions, there were presented the interim results of particular workpackages and the status of the drafting and submission of deliverables. The project partners were also informed about the accession of the new project partner, Italian textile manufacturer Tintoria Pavese SpA.

At the end of the first day, the participants moved to Dvůr Králové nad Labem. Here, after the accommodation in a hotel, they enjoyed together a dinner and informal discussions. To the relaxation after the work contributed also an guided evening walk to the city centre.

The second day of the meeting took place at INOTEX, to discuss issues concerning the communication and dissemination of results. The participants have also visited the production facilities of INOTEX.



ECWRTI, Electro Coagulation for Water Recycling in Textile Industry

The EcoloRO concept, which consist of electrocoagulation followed by membrane filtration, enables treatment of wastewater without using chemicals and it's reuse. Using this concept, the textile mills can reduce their water consumption by up to 90 percent.

Aim of the ECWRTI project is to demonstrate this technology on site at full industrial scale, first at a textile mill in Belgium and later at a textile mill in Italy.
