

ENTeR

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EU textile industry generates about 16 million tonnes of waste per year, which mostly end in landfills or incinerated. This causes a high environmental impact and loss of valuable resources. ENTeR focuses on textile waste reduction to prevent depletion of non-renewable resources, by enabling collaboration between textile companies and innovation systems across central Europe, introducing industrial symbiosis, finding new green markets for waste, and turning this stream from linear to circular.

ENTeR – Expert Network on Textile Recycling

The transnational project ENTeR funded by Interreg CENTRAL EUROPE programme focuses on waste reduction in textile industry and its use. Within the project will be established the virtual centre (the on-line platform) which will accelerate cooperation between the involved textile territories, promoting a joint offer of innovative services by the main local research centres and business associations focused to processing and recovery of textile waste. The aim is to demonstrate the benefit of an operational collaborative model among research and business partners, based on an online tool and shared skills focused on waste eco design and resource efficiency.
